MINUTES OF BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING

The meeting of the Board of Studies (BoS) commenced with the **Welcome Address** delivered by the Chairperson, **Dr. S. Prabakaran, Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering.** The Chairperson warmly welcomed all the members and expressed sincere gratitude for their valuable presence and contributions to the academic deliberations.

Dr. S. Prabakaran introduced the Anna University Nominee, Subject Experts, Industry Expert, Alumni Member, and Internal Members of the Board of Studies. He then presented the proposed **Regulation 2026 Curriculum and Syllabi** for the B.E. Electronics and Communication Engineering Programme (Semesters I and II) applicable to students admitted during the Academic Year 2026–2027.

Agenda No. 1: Welcome Address

The Chairperson welcomed the members of the Board of Studies and highlighted the importance of their expert guidance in strengthening the curriculum and ensuring academic excellence through continuous quality improvement.

Agenda No. 2: Presentation of the Curriculum

The Chairperson delivered a comprehensive presentation on the proposed **Regulation 2026 Curriculum**, explaining the curriculum framework, course structure, syllabi, course outcomes, programme outcomes, programme-specific outcomes, assessment pattern, and other academic documents pertaining to Semesters I and II of the B.E. Electronics and Communication Engineering Programme.

The members examined the curriculum and syllabi in detail and offered the following valuable suggestions.

Suggestions by the BoS Members:

- (i) It was recommended to rename the course **26UEC302 – Electromagnetic Fields and Waves** as **Electromagnetic Fields and Waveguides**.
- (ii) It was suggested to include courses such as **Monolithic Microwave Integrated Circuits (MMIC)** and **High- and Low-Power Circuits** in the curriculum.
- (iii) The department should identify and offer suitable **Open Elective** courses that can be opted for by students from other departments.
- (iv) It was suggested to include **RF and Microwave Engineering** as a course in an appropriate semester.
- (v) It was suggested that, while developing the detailed course syllabi, appropriate emphasis should be given to GATE syllabus-oriented topics to enhance students' preparedness for competitive examinations.
- (vi) The existing elective vertical on **Underwater Technology** may be replaced with **Robotics and Automation** or another emerging technology domain.
- (vii) **Wireless Sensor Networks** may also be considered as an elective course under an appropriate vertical.

The Professional Electives, Open Electives, Skill Development Courses, and Value Added Courses were discussed and approved. The Programme Outcomes (POs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs), and Course Outcomes (COs) were also reviewed and approved. The members recommended strengthening the implementation of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) practices.

The Board further emphasized enhancing industry interaction through internships, industrial visits, certification courses, mini projects, and project-based learning.

Agenda No. 3: Discussion and Approval of the Curriculum

The members of the Board of Studies discussed the proposed Regulation 2026 Curriculum and Syllabi in detail. After deliberations, the Board unanimously recommended that the suggestions received from the Anna University Nominee, Subject Experts, Industry Expert, and other members be duly considered during the finalization of the curriculum.

Resolution

The Board of Studies unanimously resolved to recommend the **Regulation 2026 Curriculum and Syllabi for the B.E. Electronics and Communication Engineering Programme (Semesters I and II)**, applicable from the Academic Year 2026–2027, to the Academic Council for its consideration and approval.

The external experts and Industry Expert appreciated the overall curriculum framework and recommended strengthening industry-oriented laboratory activities, promoting multidisciplinary projects, introducing additional emerging technology topics, and enhancing placement-oriented and research-oriented training.

The Chairperson, Dr. S. Prabakaran, thanked all the members for their valuable suggestions and active participation and declared the meeting concluded.

Vote of Thanks

The meeting concluded with the Vote of Thanks proposed by Mrs. K. Harsha, Assistant Professor. She expressed her sincere gratitude to the Chairperson, Anna University Nominee, Subject Experts, Industry Expert, Alumni Member, and all the members of the Board of Studies for their valuable suggestions, active participation, and constructive contributions.

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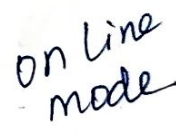

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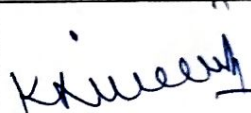

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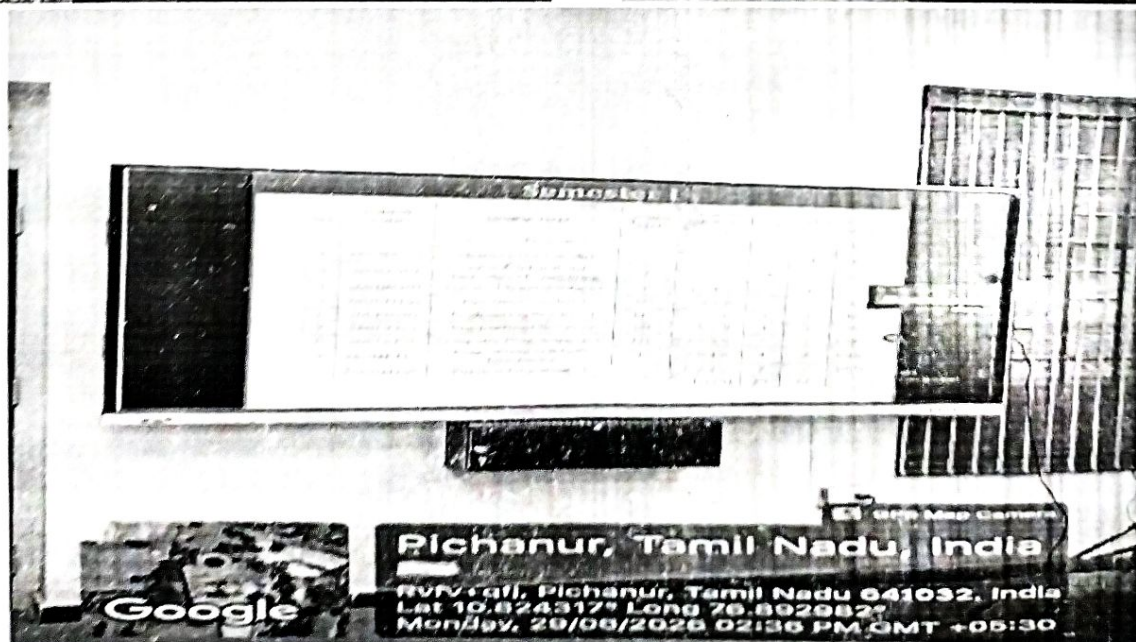
