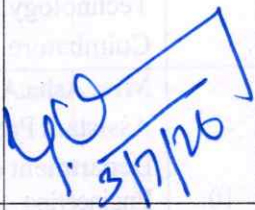
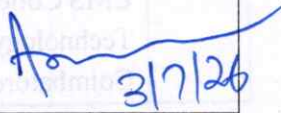
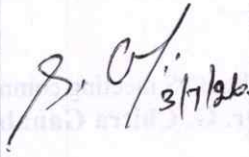

Dr. G. Chitra Ganabathi. Professor & Head, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, introduced the Anna University nominee, subject experts, and industry representative, and presented the curriculum of the B.E and M.E programme for all semesters.

Agenda No. 1: To Confirm the Constitution of the Board of Studies.

Agenda No. 2: Discussion and Approval of the Curriculum and Syllabi for the Academic Year 2026–2027 – Undergraduate Programme

The Chairperson presented the curriculum and syllabi for the B.E. programme for the academic year 2026–2027 as detailed below:

- **First and Second Semesters:** Curriculum and syllabi under **Regulations 2026**.
- **Third and Fourth Semesters:** Curriculum and syllabi under **Regulations 2025** of Anna University.
- **Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth Semesters:** Curriculum and syllabi under **Regulations 2021** of Anna University.

The Chairperson informed the members that the curriculum and syllabi for the first-year students would be implemented under the Autonomous **Regulations 2026** and the End Semester Examinations (ESE) would be conducted by the College.

Further, the members were informed that the curriculum and syllabi for the second, third, and final-year students would continue to follow the **Regulations 2025** and **Regulations 2021**, and the End Semester Examinations (ESE) for these batches would also be conducted by the College under Autonomous Status.

Resolution:

The Board of Studies approved the above recommendations for incorporation into the curriculum subject to the approval of the Academic Council with effect from the R2026 Regulations.

Agenda No. 3: Discussion and Approval of the Curriculum and Syllabi for the Academic Year 2026–2027 – Postgraduate Programme

The Chairperson presented the curriculum and syllabi for the M.E. programme for the academic year 2026–2027 as detailed below:

- **First and Second Semesters:** Curriculum and syllabi under **Regulations 2026**.
- **Third and Fourth Semesters:** Curriculum and syllabi under **Regulations 2025**.

The Chairperson informed the members that the curriculum and syllabi for the first-year postgraduate students would be implemented under the Autonomous **Regulations 2026**, and the End Semester Examinations (ESE) would be conducted by the College under Autonomous Status.

Further, the members were informed that the curriculum and syllabi for the second-year postgraduate students would continue under **Regulations 2025**, and the End Semester Examinations (ESE) would also be conducted by the College under Autonomous Status.

Resolution:

Agenda No. 4: Recommendations of the Board Members on the Curriculum and Syllabi under Regulations 2026 – Undergraduate Programme

Operating Systems

The Board recommended incorporating Linux concepts and Linux commands into the Operating Systems course to enhance students' practical exposure to Linux-based operating environments.

Software Engineering

The Board recommended Software Engineering course to incorporate Agile Software Development practices to align the course with current industry standards.

The Board members deliberated on the proposed curriculum and syllabi under Regulations 2026 for the Postgraduate Programme and made the following recommendation:

Multicore Architecture

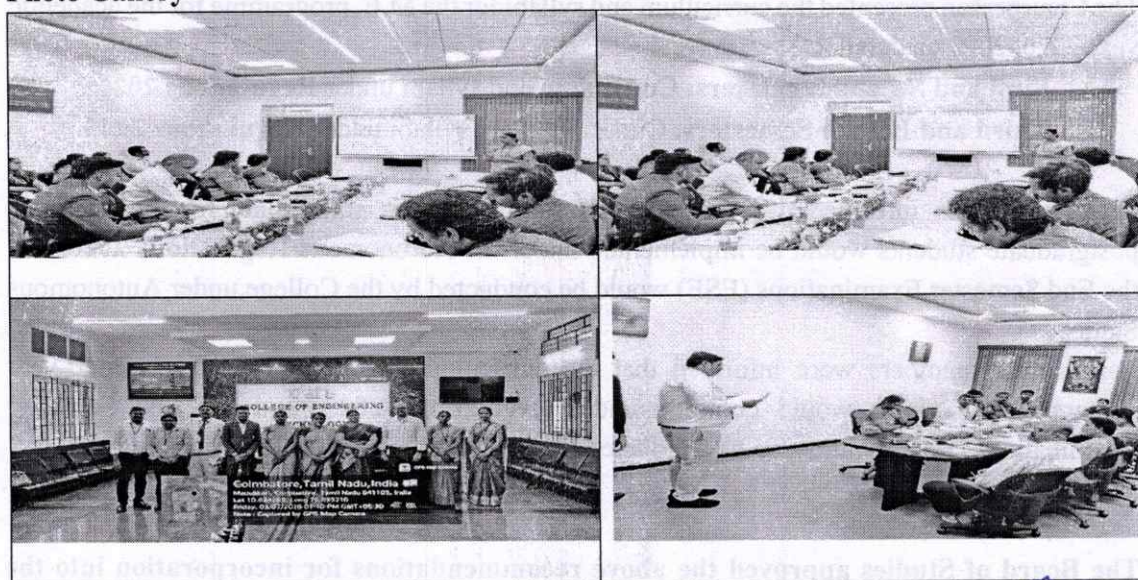
The Board recommended **Multicore Architecture** course be treated as a Theory course without laboratory component.
